DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY FOR WASHINGTON, D. C. AMTRAK TOUR

WEDNESDAY, APRIL 20, 2011.

You'll be departing by motorcoach from your designated pick-up early morning to travel to Boston's South Station. Your AMTRAK train departs at about 9:00 a.m. for Washington, D. C. Please feel free to bring lunch and/or drinks on board the train for your journey if you wish. However, you can purchase food on board the train as well. On arrival in Washington at the very historical Union Station, you will have dinner on your own at one of the many restaurants located there. It's a destination all by itself. Then we'll enjoy seeing the sights of Washington at night before heading over to the Hampton Inn, Reagan National Airport, your home for the next three nights.

THURSDAY, APRIL 21, 2011.

Start off the morning with a good breakfast at the hotel. We'll depart the hotel at 9:00 a.m. for a full day of sightseeing. Our professional step-on guide will be with us throughout the day to assist you in learning about the many famous venues in D. C. We will arrange for a tour of the Capitol through our local representative which is incredibly interesting ... that's where all the affairs of our great country are conducted. Also we'll tour Arlington National Cemetery and the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier as well as the Kennedy grave site where Teddy Kennedy was laid to rest just a short time ago. A lunch stop on your own will be made for the group. We'll return to the hotel late afternoon. The hotel has a lovely indoor swimming pool which will be a great attraction for many. We have planned a pizza party at the hotel this evening. The Metro Station is one block from the hotel should anyone wish to go back into D. C. for the evening.

FRIDAY, APRIL 22, 2011.
