- DAY #1 – TUESDAY, SEPT. 22.....**DEPART AKRON VIA DELUXE MOTOR COACH AND VISIT JAMESTOWN, NEW YORK, BIRTHPLACE OF LUCILLE BALL, THE QUEEN OF COMEDY. TOUR DESILU PLAYHOUSE AND THE LUCI-DESI MUSEUM. VISIT THE CORNING MUSEUM OF GLASS. OVERNIGHT IN BINGHAMTON, NEW YORK.
- DAY #2 – WEDNESDAY, SEPT. 23.....**DEPART BINGHAMTON, NEW YORK AND VISIT STATEN ISLAND BEFORE BOARDING THE CROWN PRINCESS IN BROOKLYN, NEW YORK DURING THE AFTERNOON. SAIL IN EARLY EVENING.
- DAY #3 – THURSDAY, SEPT. 24.....****NEWPORT, RHODE ISLAND**
