- 5:00 AM Depart Wal Mart, 3750 West Market St. in Montrose
- 5:30 AM Depart AAA Akron’s downtown location, 111 West Center St. in Akron
 Breakfast stop (on your own) / rest break en route
- 11:00 AM Arrive at the Potomac Eagle Scenic Railroad at Wappocomo Train Station in Romney, West Virginia
- 11:15 AM Board the Potomac Eagle Scenic Railroad
(This train has been featured on PBS Television’s “10 Most Scenic Train Rides in America.” The Diesel Locomotive was built in the 1950s by the Electro Motive Division of General Motors. We ride in two fabulous first class dining club cars. These vintage dining club cars are extremely rare with only four such railcars existing in the world! Each railcar has comfortable seating for 27 persons. We will enjoy a sumptuous three-course meal as we go on a three-hour narrated excursion through a tranquil and pristine Allegheny Mountain valley. Around every curve, you are rewarded with the splendor of native wildflowers, evergreens, and mixed hardwoods in various stages of fall foliage. Experience “The Trough,” a spectacular narrow mountain valley. The South Branch of the Potomac River runs below with high mountain walls and thick forest above serving as a home for the American Bald Eagle, which is spotted on 80 percent of train excursions. A completely open railcar in the rear offer great views for photographers).
- 3:00 PM Disembark the Potomac Eagle Scenic Railroad at Wappocomo Train Station in Romney, West Virginia
(Spend time exploring the unique Railroad Museum there, which features photographs and artifacts from trains around the world including China, Russia, and South Africa. It is next door to the gift shop).
- 3:30 PM Depart the Potomac Eagle Scenic Railroad in Romney, West Virginia
- 5:30 PM Arrive in Shanksville, Pennsylvania to view the Flight 93 Memorial Site for one of the hijacked planes on 9-11
- 6:00 PM Depart Shanksville, Pennsylvania and have a dinner stop (on your own) en route home
- 10:15 PM Return to AAA Akron’s downtown location, 111 W. Center St. in Akron
- 10:45 PM Return to Wal Mart, 3750 West Market St. in Montrose
