

# Hall of Fame

## Frequently Asked Questions



**Q.** Why participate in this program?

**A.** The Hall of Fame costs neither the advisor nor the school any money to participate. AAA Central Penn realizes that many schools do not have special funds to spend on incentives for Safety Patrollers. The Hall of Fame program is a reward that advisors can give their top patrollers, and an incentive for others to work towards. Just send us your nominations!

**Q.** Who is eligible to be nominated?

**A.** Any Safety Patroller in his/her *last* year of service is eligible to be nominated by a Safety Patrol advisor or Principal. Nominees do not have to perform any heroic act or life-saving deed. Critereon for nominating a patroller can include good attendance, positive attitude, excellent leadership, not exceeding authority, punctuality, and has gained respect of peers.

**Q.** Does this require a lot of work?

**A.** No! All that is required of advisors or principals is the initial nomination. AAA Central Penn will take care of contacting the nominees, judging the entries, planning the dinner ceremony and mailing the invitations. This is simply an opportunity for advisors to reward patrollers for a job well done.

**Q.** I want to be fair. How can I reward only three of my patrollers without alienating the rest?

**A.** AAA Central Penn recognizes the need to be fair to all patrollers; what you offer to one student, you must offer to all. We certainly applaud your efforts to remain impartial and un-biased in your personal opinions of your students; it's what makes you a good advisor. The "Hall of Fame" Program is not intended to create friction among patrollers and advisors, it is a reward program that allows you to give your best patrollers a chance to experience a special evening that is centered around their accomplishments. The "Hall of Fame" program is an incentive for a job well done. As long as your patrol understands that, you should have no problem justifying your decision to nominate the three patrollers who demonstrate the best work ethic.



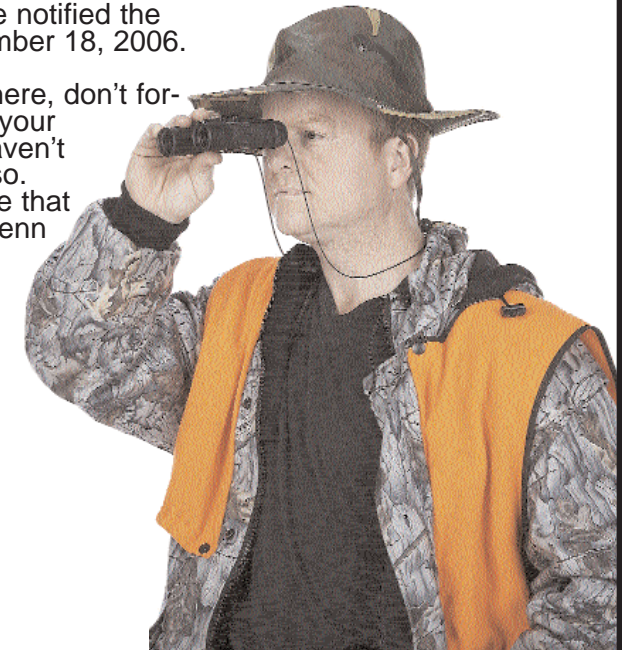

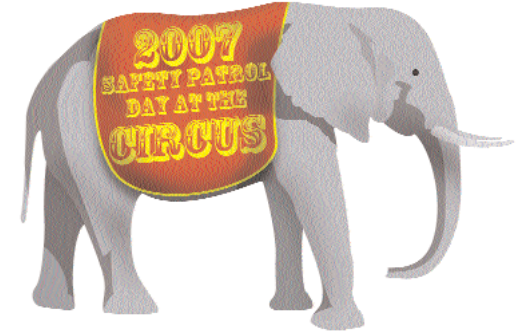
## Safety Patrol Day at the Circus scheduled for Friday March 30, 2007
