Day 1 - Heading West/ Anchorage

Depart **Harrisburg** by air for **Anchorage**. Transfer to hotel for two nights accommodations.

Day 2 - Anchorage / Portage Glacier - **Value Added Feature**

Upon arrival in Skagway, the remainder of the day is at your leisure.

Documents

Original, signed passport valid for 6 months beyond stay, and with at least one blank Visa page for Visa stamp(s).

Payment

Insurance

Alaska is not a frigid land of ice and snow! The interior around Fairbanks is warm during summer. Pack for a variety of temperatures: layers work best. Daytime, casual clothes and comfortable walking shoes are fine. For cruising, evenings require casual or semi-formal attire, with one formal night.

Baggage

Two bags per person are allowed by Holland America. Baggage fees and other charges may be directly assessed by airlines or airports.
