TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

Original, signed passport valid for 6 months beyond stay, and with at least one blank Visa page for Visa stamp(s).

PAYMENT

A deposit of \$175 per person will confirm your reservation. The balance is due to AAA by April 5, 2010.

INSURANCE
