**Hamilton**

This charming port is quintessential Bermuda, with pastel buildings and businessmen bustling around in their jackets, ties and famous shorts. **King's Wharf**

### Travel Documents

U.S. citizens on homeport cruises (cruises that begin and end at the same U.S. port) will be able to enter or depart the country with a state issued birth certificate with a raised seal and government-issued photo I.D. AAA highly recommends using a valid passport.

### Payment

A deposit of \$100 per person will confirm your reservation. Final payment is due to AAA by May 19, 2010.

### Cancellation Penalties

Day of deposit to day of departure	\$25 per person

### Insurance

Pre-existing medical conditions may be waived with proper coverage if travel insurance is purchased within 21 days of initial deposit only. Other conditions apply; ask your agent. AAA recommends Travel Guard.

### Clothing

Temperatures in Bermuda, during the summer, average in the 80's. Daytime, casual clothes and comfortable walking shoes are fine. Evenings require casual or semiformal attire, with one formal night.

### Baggage

Two bags per person will be allowed. You may also bring a small carry-on bag.

### Miscellaneous

For personal comfort, group participants who need assistance are required to have a traveling companion who is capable of and totally responsible for providing the needed assistance.
