Travel Documents

A signed passport valid for 6 months beyond stay, and with at least one blank Visa page for Visa stamp(s) is highly recommended. U.S. citizens on homeport cruises (cruises that begin and end at the same U.S. port) will be able to enter or depart the country with a state issued birth certificate with a raised seal and government-issued photo I.D.

Payment

A deposit of \$250 per person will confirm your reservation. Final payment will be due to AAA by June 11, 2010.
