St. Thomas offers every imaginable shopping opportunity and activity: snorkeling, golfing, hiking, and sailing. Just a few miles away lie St. John and Virgin Islands National Park. St. Lucia is an oasis of tropical calm nestled below the Pitons, twin peaks rising over 2,600 feet above the azure waters of the Caribbean. The island's capital of Castries is a town of charming, pastel-colored colonial buildings, home to some 60,000 souls. This beautiful island welcomes visitors drawn to its exotic tropical landscape, superb beaches, crystalline waters, and colorful marine life.

Grenada is the Caribbean's "Isle of Spice" — one of the world's major producers of nutmeg, mace, clove, cinnamon, and cocoa. Indeed, the fragrant aroma of spice seems to envelop the island's emerald hillsides, tropical forests, and sun-drenched beaches. Grenada is truly a feast for the senses.

Barbados is one of the few Caribbean islands solely colonized by one nation. Travel Documents

U.S. citizens on homeport cruises (cruises that begin and end at the same U.S. port) will be able to enter or depart the country with a state issued birth certificate with a raised seal and government-issued photo I.D. AAA highly recommends the use of a valid passport.

Payment

A deposit of 25% of the cruise fare will confirm your reservation. The balance is due to AAA by August 4, 2010.

Cancellation Penalties are as follows:

From day of booking to day of departure	\$25 per person, plus the following...
From August 18 to September 16, 2010	25% of gross fare per person, plus any additional suppliers fees
From September 17 to October 16, 2010	50% of gross fare per person, plus any additional suppliers fees
From October 17 to November 1, 2010	75% of gross fare per person, plus any additional suppliers fees
After November 1, 2010	NON REFUNDABLE

Insurance

Pre-existing medical conditions may be waived with proper coverage if travel insurance is purchased within 21 days of initial deposit only. Other conditions apply; ask your agent. AAA recommends Travel Guard.

Clothing/Climate

Temperatures for the Caribbean in November average in the 80's. Daytime, casual clothes and comfortable walking shoes are fine. Evenings require casual or semiformal attire, with three formal nights.

Baggage

Two checked bags per person are permitted. You may also bring one small carry-on.
