



## College Tour Questions

### Questions about your Major/Academics:

What are the average class sizes? (Major and Non-Major Classes; could be different)  
What percentage of classes are taught by instructors and what percentage by teaching assistants?  
Will you have access to classes in your major freshman year? If not, when?  
Where do classes in my major usually meet? What building, area of campus?  
Where do students usually study? Are there convenient study areas other than your room?  
What is the graduation rate for your major/program?  
What is the percentage of students that graduate from your major/program in 4 year or less?  
What is the registration process for classes?  
How easy is it for freshmen to get the classes they want?  
How many times a year will you see your academic advisor?  
Is your advisor in your major?  
Can you study abroad?  
How many students attend the school, in my major?  
How many graduating seniors find employment in their field upon graduation?  
What is the Accreditation of the school?

### Campus - facilities and services

Is there academic support or tutor available? (What areas of study/any costs?)  
Are computers readily available for use? (What technology?)  
How available are computers around exam time?  
Does campus have wi-fi? (PC and/or Mac compatibility)  
Is there an internship resource center?  
Do you have career counseling? (employment statistics)  
What major corporations interview here?  
What are the athletic facilities like?  
What facilities or services would they most like to see added on campus?  
What counseling services are available?  
Is there an escort service to get around campus at night?

### Your Dorm/Living:

Where will my dorm likely be located, what building; area of campus?  
How many roommates will I have (do I have a choice)?  
Are the residence halls/bathrooms co-ed?  
What percentages of students live on or off campus?  
What school activities, clubs and/or sports are available?  
Can I bring a car? Parking?  
How easy is to get places off campus?  
Is there public transportation?  
What services are offered by the campus health center?  
Is there a hospital/other services near by?

### Ask other Students:

Why did you choose this school?  
What's your least favorite thing about (insert name here)?  
What do you think the college needs to improve?  
What do you think they do well?  
Are professors accessible/helpful?  
What classes are you taking this semester?  
What do you do on a typical weekend?  
How is the food?

### Financial:

What is the cost of attendance?  
What types of financial aid are available?  
Are there scholarships available through the school?  
How do I learn about these scholarships?  
Is the Federal Work Study program available at this school?

### Things to pick up and do while on campus and in town:

Campus Newspaper  
Local Newspaper (Check out local events, happenings, job postings)  
Visit local medical walk-in center/dental office and find out if they can take your insurance  
Use public transportation
