



Atlantic Canada's Top 20 Worst Roads Named Online campaign attracts thousands of voters

CAA Atlantic's first Worst Roads campaign attracted 80,522 votes to identify the region's Worst Roads. The campaign was launched in late April and wrapped up on May 24, 2011.

"This campaign will help to put a real focus on problem and dangerous road conditions in the region," said Gary Howard of CAA. "By doing so we can actively engage all necessary levels of government to encourage repairs and changes."

The 20 Worst Roads within the region are:

1. Beaverbrook Rd, Miramichi, New Brunswick: 31,891 votes
2. Lower Maccan Road, Maccan, Nova Scotia: 28,653 votes
3. Trout Brook Road, Albert Bridge, Nova Scotia: 4,272 votes
4. Foxbrook Road, Hopewell, Nova Scotia: 3,542 votes
5. Newfoundland and Labrador 510, Port Hope Simpson, Newfoundland and Labrador: 2,495 votes
6. New Brunswick 480, New Brunswick: 1,616 votes
7. Morse Road, Bridgetown, Nova Scotia: 1,350 votes
8. Upper Leitches Creek Road, Upper Leitches Creek, Nova Scotia: 697 votes
9. Cape John Road, River John, Nova Scotia: 600 votes
10. New Brunswick 122, Eel River Lake, New Brunswick: 478 votes
11. Hillside Road, Albert Bridge, Nova Scotia: 390 votes
12. Middle River West Road, Wagmatcook, Nova Scotia: 349 votes
13. Monte Vista Road, Enfield, Nova Scotia: 335 Votes
